3 An Egyptian treasure hunt. 80 words

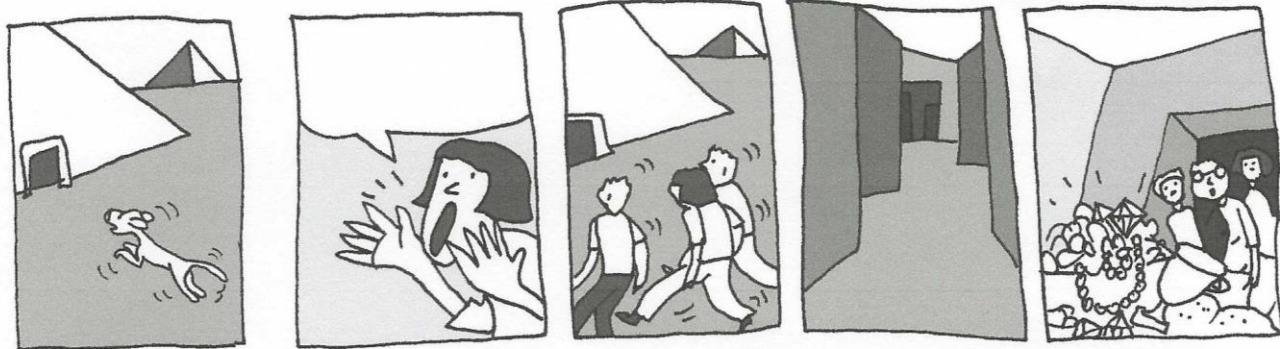
